- A) Must be a student member of CHIA **and** a member of IAHIA **or** active member of IAHIA pursuing an advanced HIM certification (CCS to RHIT, RHIT to RHIA, et cetera)
- B) Currently enrolled in a CAHIIM accredited HIA or HIT program
- C) Current enrollment verified with program director

Applicant must meet and submit the following requirements:

- A) Meet minimum 3.0 GPA (confirmed by instructor)
- B) Be in final quarter/semester of program
- C) Include a 500-word (minimum) personal essay
- D) Letter of recommendation from supervisor, instructor, or an HIM professional
- E) Unofficial transcript
