## CODING CORNER

### Coding Insertion, Removal and/or Revision of a Cerebral Ventricular Shunt: 3 Part Device

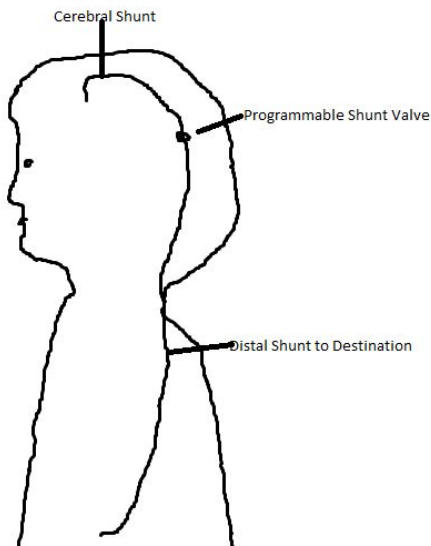
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Ventricular Shunts are used in the treatment of hydrocephalus, causing increased pressure within the cranium. Ventricular shunts make a new route for the cerebrospinal fluid. The difference between a ventriculo-peritoneal shunt and a ventriculo-atrial shunt is the location of the distal shunt to the destination point. *\*A ventricular shunt is not classified as a drainage device. The device value is "synthetic substitute" because the original root operation for placing the shunt is "Bypass" and the device placed in that root operation and now being revised is classified as a synthetic substitute.*

00160J6 Bypass, Cerebral Ventricle to Peritoneal Cavity with Synthetic Substitute, Open Approach.

00160J2 Bypass, Cerebral Ventricle to Atrium with Synthetic Substitute, Open Approach.

The below drawing shows the three-part device components:



### Removal versus Revision

If one or two of the 3 parts is removed and replaced, code Revision.

00W60JZ – Revision, Cerebral Ventricle, open, synthetic substitute

0JWS0JZ - Revision, Subcutaneous Tissue and Fascia, Head and Neck, open, synthetic substitute

0WWG4JZ – Revision, Peritoneal Cavity, percutaneous endoscopic, synthetic substitute

If all 3 parts are removed and replaced, code Removal and Bypass.

00P60JZ – Removal, Cerebral Ventricle, open, synthetic substitute

## EDUCATIONAL CORNER

We had two informative presentations at our February educational session. Our first speakers were Mark Branning, MBA, CPHIMS, SrHIMSS; and Daniel Chavez, CEO from San Diego Health Connect Health Information Exchange (HIE). Mark and Dan spoke about S.A.F.R. a real-time connection between the ambulance and emergency department (ED). S.A.F.R. which stands for Search, Alert, File, Reconcile allows paramedics to search the HIE before they reach the ED. Simply entering four data elements, the patients first name, last name, date of birth, and zip code onto a tablet will query the HIE for problems, medications, allergies, and encounters. This will tell the first responders which preferred hospital to take the patient, and alert that hospital’s ED the patient’s narrative, EKG and vital signs in real time. This reduces time and improves accuracy. The HIE is a longitudinal record which helps in filing and reconciling outcomes and billing. The next step San Diego Health Connect – HIE is taking will be incorporating the physician orders for the life-sustaining treatment (POSLT) form for first responders.

Our next presenter was by Felipe Garcia- Bigley, MHA. He gave an overview of Family Health Centers of San Diego (FHCS), which is the largest non-profit organization in San Diego County. FHCS has 23 primary care clinics, 7 dental clinics, 8 behavioral health facilities, a substance abuse treatment program, 3 mobile medical units, and a pharmacy. FHCS was founded in 1970 by Laura Rodriguez a Barrio Logan resident who recognized a lack of health care in the neighborhood and established a community health clinic. FHCS has an interface with San Diego Health Connect- HIE and has real time query capabilities, direct HL7 interfaces with local hospitals and local community partners, and also offers an ER connect referral portal. FHCS provides a patient portal called “My Health Record.” This allows patients secure access to their medical records, the ability to schedule, view, cancel, reschedule appoints; and refill medications; view labs, immunization history, and past clinic visits. Patients can download their health summaries and related topics regarding their healthcare visit. This electronic health record (EHR) is available via the internet and can be viewed on a web browser, mobile phone, or tablet.
